

ORDINANCE NO 2018- 07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE "B" OF CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 2, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, VILLAGE OF MANSFIELD, ILLINOIS REGARDING McKinley STREET

WHEREAS, the Village of Mansfield (the "Village ") is a municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs , and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations as permitted by the Illinois Municipal Code and the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities ") are committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of Village residents; and

WHEREAS, McKinley Street located in Mansfield, Illinois (the "street") is allowed for the movement of traffic in both southbound and northbound directions; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to allow only northbound traffic on McKinley Street from South Street to Oliver Street during school days, from the hours of 7:30 am 9:00am, and from 2:30pm to 4:00pm.

WHEREAS, it is understood that additional steps need to be taken to ensure that the traffic control signs are properly installed and maintained on McKinley Street; and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing , the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable le and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend Schedule "B" of Chapter 22, Article 3, Section 2 of the Municipal Code, Village Of Mansfield , Illinois (the "Village Code") as set forth below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MANSFIELD, PIATT COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

SECTION 1 INCORPORATION CLAUSE.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

SECTION 2 PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Schedule "B" of Chapter 24, Article 3, Section 2 of the Village Code to allow only northbound traffic on the McKinley Street as set forth herein and to authorize the President or his designee to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

**ARTICLE II.
AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE "B" OF CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 2 OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE, VILLAGE OF MANSFIELD, ILLINOIS**

**SECTION 3.0. AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE "B" OF CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE 3,
SECTION 2**

That the following is hereby ADDED to the Village Code notwithstanding any provision, ordinance resolution or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending and ADDING to Schedule "B" of Chapter 24, Article 3 Section 2 as follows:

Traffic on McKinley Street running north and south between South Street to Oliver Street shall be restricted to one-way traffic traveling northbound from South Street to Oliver Street during those days when school in session, from the hours of 7:30am to 9:00am, and from 2:30am to 4:00pm.

SECTION 3.1. OTHER ACTIONS AUTHORIZED.

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the amendments contemplated by this Ordinance, including taking all necessary steps to ensure the proper installation and continuing maintenance of the traffic control signs located on the Street, and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms or notices to be utilized in connection with the intent of this Ordinance .

**ARTICLE III.
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION,
EFFECTIVE DATE**

SECTION 4 HEADINGS

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance .

SECTION 5 SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative,

unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. SUPERSEDER

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 7. PUBLICATION

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force ten (10) days after its passage and approval.
