

VILLAGE OF MANSFIELD
SPECIAL MEETING
at NPPFD Meeting Room
Washington St., Mansfield, IL

August 19, 2020

The Village of Mansfield board met at 6:15pm. Roll was taken with April Manning, Lucas Gilbert, Ron Konen, Todd Jones (arrived late), Jessica Bartley, and Don Deffenbaugh (arrived late) present. Andy Stiger was absent and Ron Konen presided.

Konen said Fehr-Graham was needing a check of \$12,500 for the railroad permit. If the village does not do that work, it will be money wasted. But it would also mean more money spent later on another application if it is not paid for now. Konen said West Street is included in Phase 2. Gilbert liked holding off until next year to see if more money is received from the IL EPA. Matt with Fehr-Graham said the agreement would last pretty much forever.

Konen moved to sign the railroad agreement and issue a check for \$12,500 for the permit. No second was received. Motion died.

Konen said the Illiana Construction roadwork was complete for the summer and the bill was ready to be paid.

Jones moved, Gilbert seconded to pay the Illiana Construction oil and chip bill for \$31,618.53. Roll call: ALL Yes. Motion carried 6-0.

Konen said the village won the bid for the dump truck being sold by Monticello Township for \$28,653.

Deffenbaugh moved, Gilbert seconded to issue a check to Monticello Township for the purchase of a dump truck for \$28,653. Roll call: ALL YES. Motion carried 6-0.

There were no audience comments.

Konen moved, Gilbert seconded to adjourn the meeting. Roll call: ALL YES. Motion carried 6-0.
